About Nellis Air Force Base:

- -Part of USAF Air Combat Command (ACC base)
- -Location of the *USAF Warfare Center* providing training on all aircraft in AF inventory for all branches & international forces
- -Home of the AF Thunderbirds & USAF Weapons School
- -3 Wings (2 AD/1 Reserve) + 8 other major units make up the base; including *ISR Group*, *Rescue Group/Squadron*, & *Red Horse*
- -Began as Las Vegas Army Air Field in 1941
- -Named Nellis Air Force Base in 1950 after WW2 pilot from Southern Nevada kills in action on his 70th combat mission
- Rotations available with Flight Medicine & Rescue Squadron

About the Location:

- -Las Vegas Strip-wide varitey of entertainment available
- -Very *Family Friendly* outdoor and indoor activities throughout town
- -Surrounded by **13 National Parks**-Red Rock Canyon & Hoover Dam=within 30 mins; Valley of Fire=1 hour away
- -Mt. Charleston about 40 min drive with great hiking and outdoor activities
- -World Class Resturants throughout town
- -Very Convenient Airport with many flight options for travel all over the world

Noteworthy Highlights:

- -Wellness program includes protected time for class *Balint* monthly
- -Protected time for **All Resident Retreat** scheduled every fall, as well as individual **Class Retreats** in the spring
